Notice of Poll

Neighbourhood Plan Referendum for the Knightsbridge Neighbourhood Area

1. A referendum will be held on **18th October 2018** to decide on the question below:

“Do you want Westminster City Council to use the Knightsbridge Neighbourhood Plan to help it decide planning applications in the Knightsbridge Neighbourhood Area?”

2. The hours of poll will be from 7am to 10pm.
3. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at **Electoral Services, 2nd Floor, 5 Strand, London, WC2N 5HR** by **5pm, Wednesday 3 October 2018**.
4. Applications to vote by proxy at this referendum must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at **Electoral Services, 2nd Floor, 5 Strand, London, WC2N 5HR** by **5pm, Wednesday 10 October 2018**.
5. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this referendum on the grounds physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at **Electoral Services, 2nd Floor, 5 Strand, London, WC2N 5HR** by **5pm Thursday 18 October**. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday 10 October 2018. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday 10 October.
